# VI Sunday in Ordinary Time

# February 13, 2022

The First Reading is a little bit of wisdom poetry. It contrasts the wicked who trust in human beings and the righteous who trust in God. The former are compared to a barren desert shrub; the latter to a fruitful tree planted beside a flowing river. This prepares us for the Gospel, where Jesus declares the poor blessed. The poor are the 'little ones' who have no one to trust in but God.

# **Psalm:** Blessed the one who trusts in the Lord.

The beatitudes echo the program Jesus announced in the synagogue at Nazareth. Whereas Matthew has nine Beatitudes, Luke has only four, with, however, four corresponding 'woes'.

For this and the following two Sundays we will be reading from Luke's 'Sermon o the Plain' which parallels Matthew's 'Sermon on the Mount'.

## **Blest Are They**

Blest are they, the poor in spirit; theirs is the kingdom of God. Blest are they, full of sorrow, they shall be consoled.

Rejoice and be glad! Blessed are you; holy are you! Rejoice and be glad! Yours is the Kingdom of God!

Blest are they, the lowly ones; they shall inherit the earth. Blest are they, who hunger and thirst; they shall have their fill.

Blest are they who show mercy; mercy shall be theirs. Blest are they, the pure of heart; they shall see God!
