

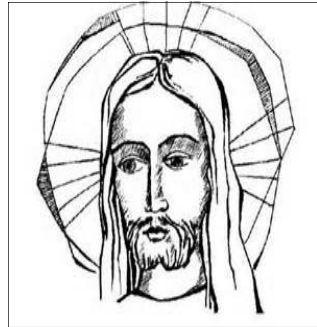
Confirmation

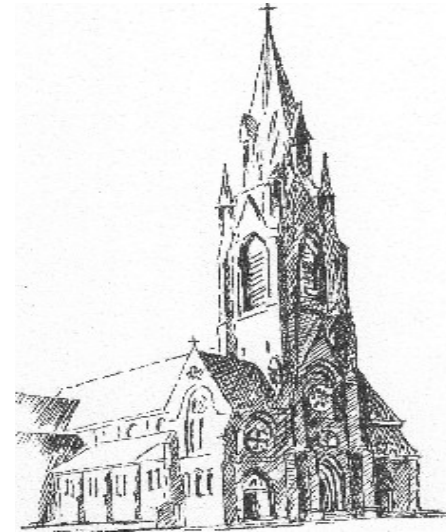

V Sunday of Easter

May 15, 2022

The First Reading tells of the conclusion of Paul's first missionary journey. He and Barnabas retrace their steps, encouraging the little communities they have founded, and preparing them for the persecutions which would inevitably come.

Psalm: *I will bless your name for ever, my King and my God.*

In the Gospel the scene is the Last Supper. Judas has departed and Jesus is alone with his own. Jesus is going forward to the cross. By so doing, he is giving glory to God, who will give glory to him. The apostles can't follow him yet.

In the meantime they are to live by a 'new commandment' - the commandment of love. It is new only in the sense that they are his disciples by their fidelity to this commandment.

The Second Reading, which comes from the final part of Revelation, is one we frequently hear at funerals. The final part of Revelation opens with a vision of a new heaven, a new earth, and a new Jerusalem.

This glorious future to which God is leading us will be fully realized only in the hereafter.
