

## XXXI Sunday in Ordinary Time October 30, 2022

First Reading (Wis 11:22-12:2) God, who created the world out of love, overlooks people's sins so that they can repent.

### Psalm: I will bless your name for ever, my King and my God.

Second Reading (2Thess 1;11-2;2) Paul urges the Thessalonians to be worthy of their call, and assures them that the Second Coming of Christ has not yet taken place.

Gospel (Lk 19:1-10) We hear the story of the conversion of the rich tax collector Zacchaeus. At that time tax-collectors were put in the same category as thieves, murders and prostitutes. Furthermore, because they worked for the Romans, they were regarded as traitors, and treated as outcasts. We can understand, then, how the good people of Jericho were offended when Jesus went to the house of Zacchaeus. But Jesus justified his action by saying that Zacchaeus too was a son of Abraham, and therefore entitled to the mercy of God as any other Israelite. And he declared that it was to seek out and save people like Zacchaeus that he had come. Touched by the kindness of Jesus, Zacchaeus saw the error of his ways and resolved to change. In this episode we again see Luke's concern for the proper use of wealth—it should be distributed to the poor.
