Our third and final ShareLife collection for this year will take place next weekend. Envelopes for this collection can be found by the church entrance. Thank you for your generosity.

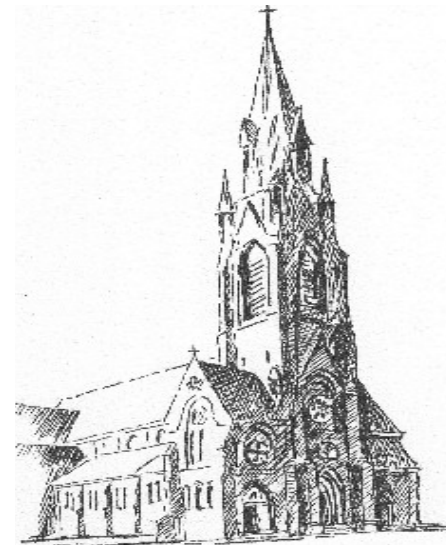


Seminarian

Pentecost

May 28, 2023

First Reading (Acts 2:1-11)

Responsorial Psalm: *Lord send forth your Spirit and renew the face of the earth.*

Second Reading (1 Cor 12:3-7.12-13)

Gospel (Jn 20:19-23)

Pentecost saw the birth of a new community, the Church. This is the day the apostles left the upper room, where they had been hiding for fear of the Jews, and went out fearlessly to preach the Gospel to the world. They could not have done this if they had not received power from on high, that is, the Holy Spirit. We too need the Holy Spirit in order to live as Christians.

Luke has the giving of the Spirit happening on the feast of Pentecost. Jewish tradition saw Pentecost as the feast of the giving of the Law on Mount Sinai. According to a legend a mighty wind turned to fire and a voice proclaimed the Law. In a further refinement, the fire split into seventy tongues of fire corresponding to the seventy nations of the world: the law was proclaimed, not only to Israel but to all humankind.
