

HOW TO PRAY THE ROSARY

1—While holding the crucifix, make the sign of the cross and then recite the Apostles’ Creed.

2—Recite the Our Father on the first large bead.

3—On each of the three small beads, recite a Hail Mary.

4—On the next large bead recite the Glory be to the Father, to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit. As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

5—Recall the first Rosary mystery and recite the Our Father on the next large bead.

6—On each of the following 10 small beads, recite a Hail Mary.

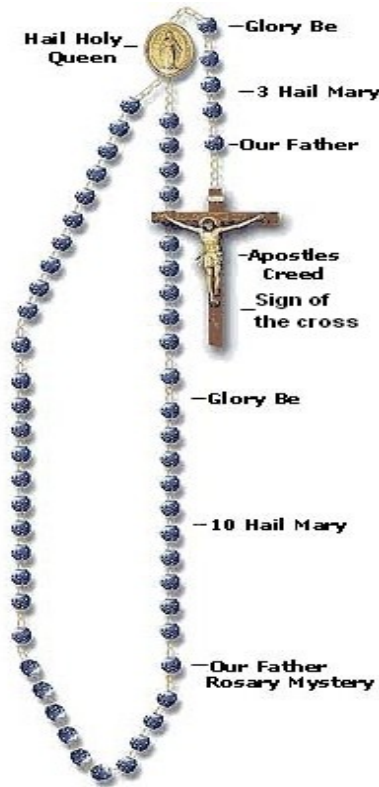
7—The next decade is the same: Our Father, 10 Hail Marys and Glory be to the Father.

Followed by the ‘*Hail, Holy Queen*’ prayer

Fatima Prayer

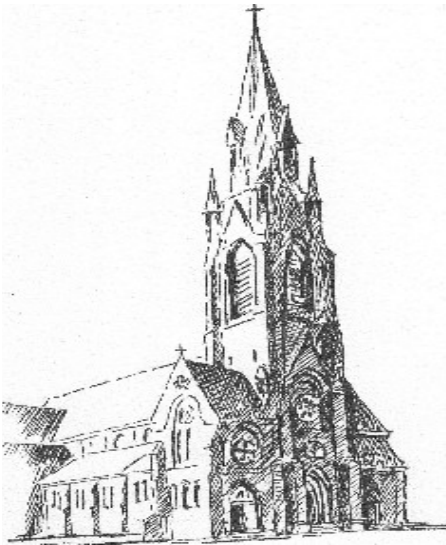
O, my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell, lead all souls to heaven especially those in most need of thy mercy.
