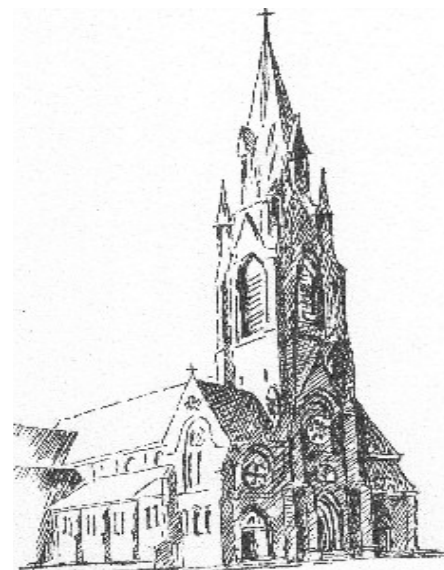

**Fifteenth Sunday  
July 14, 2024**

**First Reading (Amos 7:12-15)** The prophet Amos is faithful to the task God gave him, even though he is rejected by those to whom he is sent.

**Second Reading (Eph 1:3-14)** This is a hymn of thanksgiving to God for the great spiritual gifts he has given us in Christ.

**Psalm: Show us your steadfast love, O Lord, and grant us your salvation.**

**Gospel (Mk 6:7-13)** Jesus sends out the twelve apostles in twos as his representatives. Amos is sent to prophesy to the people of Israel. In the Gospel we have the sending out of the Twelve. Amos was a prophet by divine call. In his case the call had come to a poor, unsophisticated shepherd and ‘dresser of sycamore trees’, a total outsider to the ranks of professional prophets. Much the same could be said about the men Jesus chose ‘to be with him’. Jesus having instructed them, the time had come for them to take active part in his ministry. Their mission was an extension of his own mission, and he gave them the power to accomplish this. We come to the Lord at his invitation, to receive from him. And at the end of Mass we are sent out to share with others the gifts we have received from the Lord. Here the Lord forgives our sins, speaks his word to us, and nourishes us with the food of the Eucharist. By bringing us together he makes it possible for us to support one another.
