They are like a tree planted by the waterside, sending out its roots to the stream.


It has no worries in time of drought; its foliage stays green,

Amos was the prophet of social justice. He spoke to the wealthy of both Judah and Israel, who were unconcerned about what was happening to the country, which was about to be destroyed by the Assyrians. Indeed, by their life-style they were undermining the very fabric of the country. And they hadn't the slightest concern for the plight of the poor. Amos warned them that they would be the first to be led off into exile.

Psalm: Praise the Lord, O my soul!

This is precisely the sin of the rich man (dives) in the Gospel: cushioned by a lavish life-style, he is oblivious to the presence of a poor man at his gate.

Dives was a world-ling who didn't look beyond the good things of this life.

It's a parable about the responsibility of wealth. Some of the harshest words in the Bible are directed at the uncaring rich.

Sing a New Song

Sing a new song unto the Lord; let your song be sung from mountains high. Sing a new song unto the Lord, singing alleluia.

Yahweh's people dance for joy.
O come before the Lord.
And play for him on glad tambourines, and let your trumpet sound.

Rise, O children, from your sleep; your Saviour now has come. He has turned your sorrow to joy, and filled your soul with song.
