BLESSED VIRGIN MARY**

Saturday, August 15

**Family Walking Rosary after
the 5:00 pm English Mass.**

We invite all our parishioners and friends to join our Eucharistic Celebration and our Family Walking Rosary.

On November 1, 1950, Pope Pius XII defined the Assumption of Mary to be a dogma of faith: “We pronounce, declare and define it to be a divinely revealed dogma that the immaculate Mother of God, the ever Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul to heavenly glory.” The pope proclaimed this dogma only after a broad consultation of bishops, theologians and laity. The feast was celebrated under various names—Commemoration, Dormition, Passing, Assumption—from at least the fifth or sixth century. Today it is celebrated as a solemnity.

No dia 1 de novembro de 1950, o Papa Pio XII definiu a Assunção de Maria como um dogma de fé: «Pronunciamos, declaramos e definimos ser um dogma divinamente revelado que a Imaculada Mãe de Deus, a sempre Virgem Maria, tendo completado o curso da sua vida terrena, foi elevada em corpo e alma à glória celeste». O Papa proclamou este dogma somente após uma ampla consulta aos bispos, teólogos e fiéis leigos. Esta festa foi celebrada sob vários nomes, como Comemoração, Dormição, Passagem e Assunção, pelo menos desde os séculos V ou VI. Hoje, é celebrada como uma solenidade.
